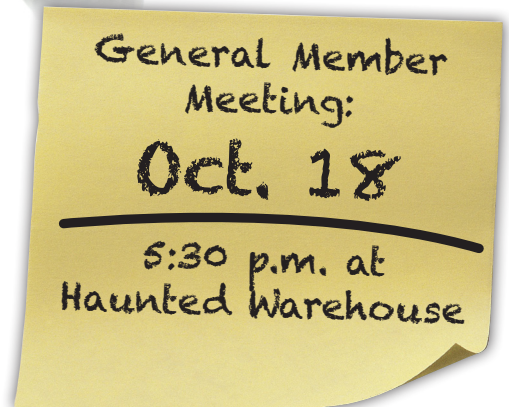
soon as possible, we will need to have our chairs in place by the October membership meeting.
